U.S. Survey No. 10247 was surveyed by Paul L. Moss, Cadastral Surveyor, in 1989.

This survey was executed by Steven G. Schmitt, Cadastral Surveyor, September 15 through September 19, 1989, in accordance with the specifications set forth in the Manual of Surveying Instructions, 1973, Special Instructions dated September 1, 1989, approved September 15, 1989; Solomon ANCSA 14(c) Plan of Survey approved August 11, 1990; and Assignment Instructions dated September 15, 1989.

Area: 23.91 Acres.

The azimuth was obtained from direct observations of the sun, using the hour angle method, and refers to the true meridian.

The geographic position of corner No. 6, Lot 1, as determined from a tie to National Geodetic Survey triangulation station "SOLAIR 1969," is:

Latitude: 64° 33' 31.72" North

NAD 27

Longitude: 164° 26' 49.41" West

The mean magnetic declination was obtained from U.S. Geological Survey quadrangle map "SOLOMON (C-5)," Alaska, 1950 edition, with minor revisions in 1973.

The staking of lots within the survey was completed by the Solomon Native Corporation Representative prior to the survey and was used to establish the location of lots.

This survey is located at the village of Solomon, Alaska, within Township 11 South, Range 19 West, Kafeel River Meridian, Alaska.

The land is rolling open tundra, covered with native grasses; underlain with sand and clay.

Access to the survey was by helicopter.


