Area:

The Upper Railbelt REAA includes area within the Doyon, Limited Corporation boundaries and the Ahtna Incorporated Corporation boundaries with the following communities:

Boundary:

Beginning at the southeasternmost point of the boundary of the City of Anderson; thence northerly and westerly along the eastern and northern boundaries of the City of Anderson to the northwesternmost corner of the City of Anderson, thence west to the intersection with 151° W Longitude; thence south along 151° W Longitude to the intersection with the northern boundary of the Matanuska-Susitna Borough; thence northerly and easterly along the northern boundary of the Matanuska-Susitna Borough to the intersection with 147° W Longitude; thence north along 147° W Longitude to the intersection with the southern boundary of the Fairbanks North Star Borough; thence westerly and northerly along the southern and western boundary of the Fairbanks North Star Borough to the Latitude containing the southeasternmost point of the City of Anderson; thence west to the point of the beginning.

NUMBER OF SECTIONS 4 (7 SEATS)

Section I (2 seats-A,B) Anderson

This section includes all that territory North of approximately latitude 64° 22'N and lies within the boundaries of Region #14. This section includes all the area in the Anderson City limits.

Section II (1 seat-C) Brown's Court & Clear

This section includes all that territory South of latitude 64° 22'N and North of Latitude 63° 55'N and lies within the boundaries of Region #14. This section excludes all the area in the Anderson City limits.

Section III (3 seats-D,E,F) Healy & McKinley

This section includes all that territory South of latitude 63° 55'N and North of latitude 63° 36'N and lies within the boundaries of Region #14.

Section IV (1 seat-G) -Cantwell

This section includes all that territory South of Latitude 63° 36'N and is identified at the point where the right angle in the Nenana River and the new bridge is located north of Carlo.
