MAP NOTES

This map was prepared for Kawerak, Inc. in cooperation with the Alaska Department of Community and Regional Affairs (DCRA), Municipal and Regional Assistance Division, using funds provided by the U.S. Bureau of Indian Affairs. Kawerak, Inc. contracted with McClintock Land Associates, Inc. in 1996 to prepare the map.

This map is based upon a digital orthophoto prepared to National Map Accuracy Standards by AeroMap, U.S. Inc. from their July 12, 1994 photography (original scale 1" = 833').

The orthophoto is an aerial photo which has been corrected, by rectification to ground control stations, to remove distortions and warpage due to ground topography and aircraft tilt and trim.

This map should not be construed as a survey. On-site surveys should be conducted prior to engineering or construction.

Property and utility information has been generated from the best available sources with limited accuracy checks. Utility location is particularly imprecise and shows only the main lines as the service lines have been omitted for clarity. Generally, the information is current as of May, 1996.

Sivuaqa Native Corporation has received surface and subsurface title to its former reserve lands through section 19(b) of ANCSA. The land is not subject to the reconveyance requirements of section 14(c) of ANCSA.

FLOOD DATA

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (C.O.E.) has not established exact flood data for this community.

"#50391, FAA 1940" is a brass cap, located in the well point concrete pad on the west edge of Troutman Lake, as shown on Sheet D-1, dated 1963, drawn by Chuck Egner Consulting and Engineers for Village Safe Water.

Flood Hazards may exist in this community. Contact C.O.E. or DCRA Flood Hazard Specialist for safe building elevations.



