


Community Map -- The profile maps illustrate land use patterns, land status, location of power lines, water resources, waste disposal sites, public facilities and other improvements. They also depict some of the natural features and hazards that affect the community. This information is very useful in planning for community improvements and expansion.

The Community Map shown here was prepared from an uncontrolled aerial photograph taken in 1982 by Walker and Assoc. that was enlarged from a scale of 1" = 1,500' to 1" = 250'. The Area Map was prepared from an uncontrolled NASA photograph provided by BLM, taken in 1979 at a scale of 1" = 10,000'.
