


MAP NOTES

This map was prepared under the direction of the Northwest Arctic Borough by McClintock Land Associates, Inc. It was funded by the Alaska Coastal Management Program, Office of the Governor, pursuant to National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) Award No. NA77020178 and the NANA Regional Corporation. The NOAA grant has been administered by the Alaska Office of the Governor, Division of Governmental Coordination, and the Department of Community and Regional Affairs, Municipal and Regional Assistance Division.

This map is based upon a digital orthophoto prepared to National Map Accuracy Standards by AeroMap, U.S., Inc. from their July, 1995 photography (original scale 1" = 700').

The orthophoto is an aerial photo which has been corrected, by rectification to ground control stations, to remove distortions and warpage due to ground topography and aircraft tilt and trim.

This map should not be construed as a survey. On-site surveys should be conducted prior to engineering or construction.

Property and utility information has been generated from the best available sources with limited accuracy checks. Utility location is particularly imprecise and shows only the main lines. The service lines have been omitted for clarity. Generally, the information is current as of December 1, 1997.
