


The Community Map shown here was prepared from an aerial photograph taken in 1979 by North Pacific Aerial Survey at a height of 8400 feet and enlarged to a scale of 1" = 300'. The Area Map was taken in 1974 by BLM at a height of 8400 feet and reproduced at a scale 1:16800 (1" = 1400').




Wildlife Resource Map


