







Notes:  
 1. The Port Graham and English Bay Corporations hold title to the surface estate of ANCSA lands on their respective sides of the boundary line.  
 2. Additional private lands and village corporation lands are within the townships of English Bay (U.S. Survey No. 4901) and Port Graham (U.S. Survey No. 4999) but are too small to be shown clearly hereon.  
 3. The BLM village selection maps & village corporation conveyance documents depict the 17(b) easements as shown hereon. However, these easements are not valid or enforceable where they cross Native allotments, unless the allottee grants an easement after certification. The status and/or location of easements may change following final ANCSA conveyances and BLM easement conformance process.
