


Community Map SAINT MARY'S

MAP NOTES
The Governor requested and the Alaska State Legislature appropriated to the Department of Community and Regional Affairs (DCRA) funding for the community map shown hereon. DCRA contracted with R&M Consultants, Inc. in February, 1994 to design and prepare the map.

This map is based on an orthophoto prepared from aerial photography taken in June, 1991 by AeroMap U.S. The orthophoto is an aerial photograph which has been corrected (rectified) by removing the distortions present in the original photograph; distortions can result from aircraft tilt and from changes in ground elevation.

This map should not be construed as a survey. On-site surveys should be conducted prior to engineering or construction.

Property and utility information has been generated from the best available sources with limited accuracy checks. Generally the information is current as of May, 1994.

Electric and telephone systems consist of primary and secondary cables and service lines. The systems shown here are simplified for clarity.

The Andreafsky Federal Townsite is now within the Municipal boundaries of the City of St. Mary's.

FLOOD DATA
The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (C.O.E.) has not established exact flood data for this community. From four floods of record and some computation the C.O.E. estimates the 100-year flood elevation is 32' M.S.L.

This project established a benchmark for reference for flood data reference:
BM-1 - Top of Manhole Cover, Elev. = 25.0' M.S.L.
